#### **New Business**

#### Fresno Competition Update:

- Lots of wide ranging discussion.
- Reported that our insurance does cover overnight trips
- Official Chaperone slots already filled--thanks!
- Costs
  - Hotel: 2235.60 for chaperones and students. (There are 8 hotel rooms for parents to pay separately if they wish to reserve)
  - Bus: \$2600 (this is educated guesstimate based on field show bus costs. There
    has been a delay in getting info from JUHSD due to staff not being avail.)
  - Truck: \$800 (including gas and extra mileage)
  - Food: \$1,300 (including dinner out on Saturday night)
  - o Fees: \$700
- Hotel is the Comfort inn in Hanford. 3-4 kids to a room. Official chaperones must stay in hotel.
- Volunteers: need 9 for food and 6-8 for pit
- Breakfast is included in hotel stay
- Leave very early on Saturday morning (3:30 am?) Competing Saturday, and depending on Saturday results either competing on Sunday or watching competitions.
- (be alert that this is the weekend before Thanksgiving week, and that UC apps are due.)
- After considering Winter Program presentation below, M/S/A \$8,000 for Fresno program

# **Winter Program presentation by Noah Peters:**

- Proposal covers coaching fees and competition, proposal is \$11,738 for both Winterguard (colorguard) and Winter Percussion (drumline) programs.
- Programs would start after the close of marching band and continue through 1st week of April.
- Winterguard would compete in the California Color Guard Circuit, mostly in the South Bay.
- Percussion would be mostly East Bay and South Bay with the NCPA
- There is some leeway in that budget depending on borrowing materials/using existing flags & home-source costumes
- Need to know if program is a go by 11/1
- Noah would be coach for Winter Guard, Oliver Bishop for Percussion. (a little about Oliver: SFSU Music Ed degree in progress, Blue Devils B drum major 2 years, 500+ hours private teaching...)
- Financial note....Brian says that we have 10k budgeted for instruments this year, but we will only NEED about \$1,200 so that gives some leeway.
- Board is interested in and favorably disposed towards proposal, would like some more time to think and consider at the October meeting.
